

2010 Yadkin Challenge: 2-man Team Tournament Trail



Membership: A membership fee of \$30 is required to fish these events unless you are already a member of the NC BASS Federation Nation. Member number is required at registration to wave this fee. If you are already a member of BASS, membership in NC BASS Federation Nation is available for an additional \$10. This will allow you to qualify for NCBFN Benefits and qualifying events towards the prestigious BASS Masters Classic (see website or contact Chuck Murray at 919-853-6918 or email at leanliner@aol.com for more details).

Payout: \$60 per team. 83% Payback at the ramp.

8.5% Proceeds benefit conservation and youth programs

8.5% Cumulative payback at October

Per entry fee payback:

\$20 = 1st place

\$13 = 2nd place

\$7 = 3rd place

\$10 = big fish

Limit: 5 fish aggregate, one or two man team, NC Wildlife Resources Commission Creel Limits apply.

Schedule:

March 20	Safe Light to 3 pm	Badin Lake, Circle Drive Ramp
April 10	Safe Light to 3 pm	Tuckertown, Graveyard Ramp
June 12	Safe Light to 3 pm	High Rock, Southmont Ramp
August 14	Safe Light to 3 pm	Tuckertown, Graveyard Ramp
October 9	Safe Light to 3 pm	High Rock, Southmont Ramp

Pre-registration is preferred. On-site registration will begin 45 minutes to tournament. Limit 50 boats.

RULES:

1. Contestants are expected to provide appropriate insurance for themselves and their partners. The sponsors of this tournament are not liable for any accidents or negligence in any way.
 2. No illegal substances or other contraband is allowed. It is the contestant's responsibility to know and abide by applicable rules and laws of the site.
 3. All NC Wildlife Resource Commission rules concerning creels and safety will be followed at all times. Failure to do so will mean disqualification.
 4. No live bait
 5. Only species of black bass will be weighed
 6. 5 fish aggregate limit whether one or two fishermen
 7. All contestants are subject to take a polygraph. Anyone refusing to take the test will be disqualified and their membership will be revoked.
 8. Blast off will be one boat at a time by sign up order at a point designated outside the no wake area. Mailed entries will be by postmark. Multiple forms received the same day will be by lottery.
 9. Points system: 50 points will be awarded to BOTH team members and decline by one point for each place until no fish are weighed per team. This allows teams to fish with other available members.
 10. Substitutes are allowed but must pay the membership fee.
 11. Any team late for weigh-in will be disqualified. On time is boat inside no wake area of launch and no faster than no wake speed.
 12. Measurement will be by Golden Rule with mouth closed. Any team attempting to weigh a short fish will be penalized the short fish and a 1 pound penalty. A courtesy measure may be requested but must be done so BEFORE presenting fish.
 13. 1 pound penalty for dead fish
 14. Teams that are tied at the end of weigh-in will split the prize money. Points will be awarded without split.
 15. Protests: Good sportsmanship is expected at all times. There are no standoff requirements and will not be considered a valid protest. Rule protests must be filed with the tournament director before weigh-in begins. All decisions of the tournament director are final.
