NC BASS FEDERATION NATION TEAM-TOURNAMENT TRAIL
2011 RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Contestants may not use live bait.
2. There will be a seven fish limit with two fish being at least 12 inches, and 5 over 14 inches where allowed.
3. **All contestants are subject to be asked to take a polygraph.** Anyone refusing to take the test, will be disqualified and have their membership revoked.
4. Entry fee is as follows: \$110 for the tournament includes the big fish pot.
5. Blast off will occur by sign up.
6. Ending times will be announced at the tournament.
7. **Points system:**
First place team will receive 100 points, 2nd place 98 points etc.... **The Points Championship will be based on each team's final score.** Subs are allowed, but must join the trail. *If a team zeros during a tourney, they will receive 10 points less than the last place team recorded.*
8. Any team late for weigh-in will be disqualified.
9. Any team attempting to weigh a short fish will be penalized that fish *plus a pound penalty.* In measuring a fish, the mouth must be completely closed and head touching the golden rule. A courteous measure will be allowed if requested. Fish must be tagged and presented at weigh-in.
10. There will a 1/4 pound penalty for a dead fish.
11. **If two teams are tied at tournament end, they will split the prizes.**
12. **Protest:** must be filed to the Tournament Director before weigh-in ends. All decisions by the tournament director are final.
13. **There will be 5 official tournaments.**
